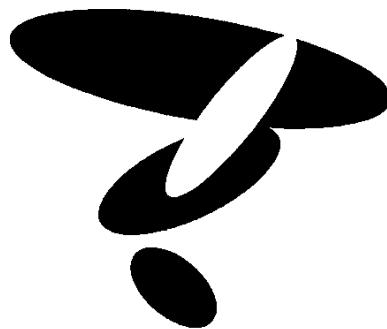

## Guidelines for Applicants



**TEIKYO**

Teikyo-Harvard Program

1. Enrollment Number of Students

The enrollment number of students is limited to thirty (30) per course.

2. Eligibility

- (1) Bachelor's (or higher) degree holders.
- (2) Those who are considered having equivalent academic competence above.
- (3) Those who are able to take courses more than ten (10) hours per week for complying the eligibility to obtain a visa for Japan.

3. Courses and Credits

- (1) Applicant can register up to four courses and may take the accepted courses only.
- (2) Upon completion of taking and passing the final examination, students will be granted credit(s) (1.0 unit per course) with transcripts issued.
- (3) Credits will not be granted to auditing students.

Note: The lectures and examinations are all conducted in English. If English is not your first language, the suggested TOEFL scores are shown below for your reference:

- iBT: 79-80 or above
- PBT: 550 or above
- CBT: 213 or above

4. Admission Processing Fee (※) : 35,000 Yen (for students earning credit)  
20,000 Yen (for auditing students)

※ Free for those who attend the affiliated schools

5. Supporting Documents

Applicants must submit the following documents:

a) Letter of reference

One (1) letter from an administrator (Dean, Department Head, etc.) of school or institute the applicant is currently enrolled or employed.

Be sure to include the following information of a reference:

- Full name
- Gender
- Affiliation
- Address
- Signature.

b) A photocopy of passport

c) A copy of diploma (not required for the applicants from the affiliated schools)

Official copy of graduation certificate (diploma) from your institution of higher education.

※The school may request for additional documents to those who are not from the affiliated schools.

6. Enrollment Term

The courses of Harvard Special Session 2014 are conducted from January 11, 2014 to February 4, 2014.

The term of the enrollment is one (1) month on and after January 11, 2014.

7. Registration Fee and Tuition

(1) The payment required is listed below for students earning credits:

(Unit: Japanese Yen)

Registration fee for a month	30,000
Tuition (per course, per credit)	22,000

Ex. for two courses, it makes JPY 74,000 in total.

(Registration fee: 30,000 + Tuition 44,000)

(2) The payment required is listed below for auditing students:

(Unit: Japanese Yen)

Registration fee for a month	15,000
Tuition (per course, per credit)	22,000

Ex. for two courses, it makes JPY 59,000 in total.

(Registration fee 15,000 + Tuition 44,000)

8. Procedure for Registration

Registration will be completed by submitting the application form and all the supporting documents with full payment of fee and tuition in Japanese Yen. However, it is an option for you to make a payment at the office of Teikyo University upon your arrival. Please consult us in advance.
