Teikyo University invites five professors every January from world-renowned universities such as Harvard, Cambridge, Oxford, and Durham to provide us intensive courses since 2012, followed by the establishment of Graduate School of Public Health. The courses are designed to serve as a part of competency-based education which Teikyo SPH embraces as a methodology, and cover five core areas required by the Council of Education for Public Health: *Epidemiology, Biostatistics, Environmental Health Sciences, Health Policy and Management*, and *Social and Behavioral Sciences*.

The teaching style is very interactive, including many discussions in a small group, where students have many opportunities to exchange their ideas and to speak directly with prominent professors. Throughout the courses, it is a great opportunity for students to learn from professors, from fellow students and from themselves. A certificate is to be given upon a completion of the course, signed by each professor with the endorsement of Teikyo University Graduate School of Public Health. This special session is one of Teikyo's academic collaborations with these universities since early 1990s.

Past sessions had approximately hundred participants a year. In addition to domestic participant, students from all over the world including the United States, China, Taiwan, Indonesia, the Philippines, Thailand, as well as African and Caribbean countries, made a contribution to giving a global atmosphere to classroom. We welcome you all and look forward to having everyone with diverse background and passion for public health!
