Aug. 12 - 15

Healthcare Management - Organizational Behavior in Public Health

This course will introduce you to the basic principles of organizational behavior. These principles have become increasingly important in research, practice and policy making in the public health sector. The main objective of the course is to familiarize the students with the basic concepts and tools of organizational behavior used in research and in practice, and to serve as an introduction to more advanced courses in public health leadership.

Aug. 21 - 26

Universal Health Coverage and Aging Population

Achievement of the universal health coverage (UHC) is one of the most important problems in public health. This course will introduce you to the situation of the universal health coverage in Japan. For example, history toward UHC in Japan: Lessons and challenges, health policy and strategy for UHC in Japan : Japan Vision Health Care 2035, principles of planning for a healthy community, the role of a local government and communities for urban aging community and so on.
